

Lower Reserve, and a 600 lbs bell was placed in the tower. Previous to the erection of these Churches, there was no decent place where the Indians could meet for divine worship: they usually met in the Chief's house or wigwam, or any where that was thought most convenient. The Lower Reserve, whose Indian name is Krath-meh, as for chief Charley, another son of Shit-hit-sa: but all the Indians recognise Celestin.
