# CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO. There is a fair movement of all kinds of

lumber, and particularly of low grade pine and hardwoods. Orders appear to be a little more plentiful than earlier in the month. It is generally believed that consumers are carrying light stocks, as their policy for some time past has been to buy conservatively in the hope of being in a position to take advantage of the expected decline in prices, which up to the present time has not materialized. Manufacturers of pine lumber do not anticipate lower prices in the near future. Even if the demand this winter should fall below normal, it is not likely that the effect upon prices would be material, as the pine manulacturers are in a strong financial position. Unless there should be a permanent decline in the volume of trade, prices will not yield. Hardwood manufacturers are equally certain of being able to maintain present prices. The quantity of unsold stock at the mills is exceptionally light, and the supply will be shorter this winter than during the corresponding season a year ago. The stumpage price for hardwoods has advanced in full sympathy with the higher prices for lumber, which consideration warrants the view that present values will continue. By some an advance in the price of the thicker sizes of hardwoods is predicted. A manufacturer who has been selling his basswood at \$20 for mill run culls out writes that he has just received an offer of \$22, which clearly in-
