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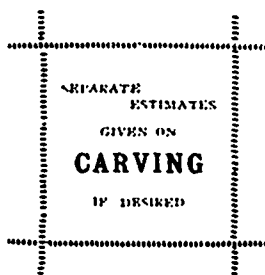
A teaspoonful in a glass of water sweetened to taste makes a delicious and cooling drink.

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
