

- (2) Canadian citizens who are bona-fide non-immigrants and who are in possession of valid national passports may, without previously obtaining an Italian visa, visit Italy for periods each not exceeding three consecutive months. This modification of entrance requirements does not apply to Canadian citizens who wish to enter the trust territory of Somaliland under Italian administration.
- (3) It is understood that this modification of entrance requirements does not exempt Italian and Canadian citizens, coming respectively to Canada and Italy, from the necessity of complying with the laws and regulations of the country concerned regarding the entry, residence (temporary or permanent) and employment or occupation of foreigners, and that persons who are unable to comply with the laws and regulations are liable to be refused leave to enter or land.

If the Government of Italy is prepared to accept the foregoing provisions, the Government of Canada has the honour to suggest that this note and the reply thereto of the Government of Italy shall constitute an agreement which shall take effect on the thirtieth day following the date of the latter's note.
