There is some variation within sub-groups of the Canadian population as to who is most likely to support Canada's current policy towards Cuba. These groups àre as follows:

- $90 \%$ of university graduates ( $49 \%$ strongly, $41 \%$ somewhat)
- $87 \%$ of those earning more than $\$ 60 \mathrm{k}$ ( $44 \%$ strongly, $43 \%$ somewhat)
- $86 \%$ of British Columbians ( $43 \%$ strongly, $43 \%$ somewhat)
- $86 \%$ of Quebecers ( $36 \%$ strongly, $50 \%$ somewhat)
- $85 \%$ of Saskatchewan/Manitoba residents ( $34 \%$ strongly, $51 \%$ somewhat)
- $86 \%$ of Canadians over the age of 55 ( $48 \%$ strongly, $38 \%$ somewhat)
- $85 \%$ of men ( $45 \%$ strongly, $40 \%$ somewhat)
