

There is some variation within sub-groups of the Canadian population as to who is most likely to support Canada's current policy towards Cuba. These groups are as follows:

- 90% of university graduates (49% strongly, 41% somewhat)
- 87% of those earning more than \$60k (44% strongly, 43% somewhat)
- 86% of British Columbians (43% strongly, 43% somewhat)
- 86% of Quebecers (36% strongly, 50% somewhat)
- 85% of Saskatchewan/Manitoba residents (34% strongly, 51% somewhat)
- 86% of Canadians over the age of 55 (48% strongly, 38% somewhat)
- 85% of men (45% strongly, 40% somewhat)
