Senator Renaude Lapointe was previously a journalist concentrating particularly on social welfare, education and political reporting. She was a member of the staff of Le Soleil, Quebec and later La Presse, Montreal and was the first woman editorial writer in the French language press of Canada. She has also worked for the International Service of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation and has been a script writer for various television and radio programs. More recently, Senator Lapointe was Information Officer in the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development. In 1970 and 1971 she was a member of the Canadian Delegations to the 25th and 26th sessions of the United Nations General Assembly. In 1971 she was named to the Senate of Canada.
