Mr. Campbell (LaSalle-Émard-Côte Saint-Paul), from the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications, presented the Second Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

While considering Bill S-11, An Act respecting British Columbia Telephone Company, your Committee agreed unanimously to report the following to the House:

Your Committee recommends that the charges of \$200,400 paid by British Columbia Telephone Company, in accordance with Standing Order 91 (4), be held in abeyance until the House has disposed of Bill C-29, An Act respecting Canadian business corporations, at which time the question be considered.
