**Mr. Pickersgill:** Before the minister concludes I wonder whether he would permit a question. Can the minister say whether it is the intention of the government to appoint a successor to Mr. Dunton pending the bringing down of their new legislation?

Mr. Nowlan: I would not want to give a definite answer. Frankly, I think it would depend on circumstances. If we can bring the legislation in at the time I hope, see the framework that is provided under the legislation and the legislation is enacted, then, as the Fowler commission has pointed out and as this party pointed out in days gone by when we were in opposition, there obviously would be an independent regulatory body of some kind and one would assume, whatever the details might be, that some board would be set up such as that which might or might not obviate the necessity of filling the vacancy. At the moment there is a vice-chairman, of course. This is not the general manager of the corporation. As the hon. member well knows, this vacancy is that of the chairman of the board of governors. There are vacancies on the board now, and perhaps it would be rather invidious to appoint one person, make him chairman and not fill all the vacancies. That is a matter which the government will have to decide depending upon circumstances and the progress made in the house.
