There was no part of my predecessor's duties in which he took a more lively interest, and before demitting office he impressed on the the desirability of keeping prominently before my Committee the whole subject of the reciprocal interchange of teachers with a view to the continuance of the scheme inaugurated last year. I am very anxious to follow out Mr. Malloch's wishes in this matter, and, accordingly, am taking steps to put before my Committee the question of the continuance of these scholarships at an early date. I feel certain that my Committee would wish to have some indication of the progress made by the students selected to go to McGill University and also to have your opinion on his general suitability for the needs of the scheme. Although it will be rather early for you to give any final and definite report on the quality of Mr. Gower's work, I should, nevertheless, esteem it a great favour if you could furnish me with a provisional report on the character of his accomplishments during the period of his residence with you. I am sorry to trouble you at this stage on the matter of reports, but this is the kind of thing which must be tackled fairly early so that ample time may be given for future nominations.
