January Twenty-sixth 1921. Dear Sir:-Special Library Committee. Will you consent to serve on a Committee composed as follows:-Mr. Wm. M. Birks, representing the Governors. Dr. G. R. Lomer, Professor Smith, Mr. F. Cleveland Morgan, Dr. G. M. Byers. This Committee has been constituted for the purpose of considering plans for the extension of the Library in order to provide accommodation sufficient for the requirements of the next ten years, at least. As a result of your conclusions the Architect chosen will be better able to make his plans. It is, of course, to be understood that any conclusions reached must be submitted to the Board of Governors for their approval before any definite action as regards alteration or construction can be taken. I mention this because I do not want the general body of teachers, students or public to get any wrong impressions as to what may or may not be done in the matter of a building Mr. Wm. M.
