Table for Foretelling the Weather through all the Lunations of each Year.

This Table, and the accompanying remarks, are the result of many years' actual observation ; the whole being constructed on a due consideration of the attraction of the Sun and Moon, in their several positions respecting the Earth, and will, by simple inspection, shew by observer what kind of weather will most probably follow that as to be the Moon into any of its quarters, and that so near as to be seldom found to fail.

If the new moon, the $\frac{1}{4}$ quarter, the full moon, or the last quarter happens	IN SUMMER.	IN WINTER.

— 4 and 6 P. M.	Fair.	Fair and mild.
— 6 and 8 "	Fair, if wind N. W.	Fair.
— 8 and 10 "	Rainy, if S. or S. W.	Fair and frosty, if wind N. or N. E.
— 10 and midnight.	Ditto.	Rain or snow, if S. W.

Observations.—The nearer the time of the Moon's change to noon or night, the more nearly will the result accord with the prediction. It is also said that less dependence is to be placed on the Table in summer.
