SECTION 9. That all the powers and authority heretofore vested in the Justices of the Peace, acting for their respective Divisions by the twentieth section of the first of Victoria chapter 21, entitled, "An Act to alter and amend sundry Acts regulating the appointment and duties of Township Officers," be hereafter vested in, and may be exercised by the Councillor or Councillors (as the case may be) representing their several and respective Townships within the Townships they may represent respectively, so far as the said powers and authority appertain to, or are connected with the appropriation, controul, management and distribution of the statute labour within their several and respective Townships.

BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the District of Johnstown, to regulate the appointment and duties of Pound Keepers.

The Council of the District of Johnstown duly assembled in Council in the Town of Brockville on Friday the eleventh day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two in virtue of an Act passed in the fourth and fifth years of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, entitled "An Act to provide for the better internal government of that part of this Province which formerly constituted the Province of Upper Canada by the establishment of Local or Municipal Authorities therein," do ordain and enact the following By-Law, and it is hereby enacted, That each and every Township shall be authorised to choose and elect at their annual Township Meetings so many fit and proper persons, to serve the office of Pound Keeper, as in their discretion they may see fit, not to exceed twelve in any one Township.
