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FRICTION WITH GERMANY.

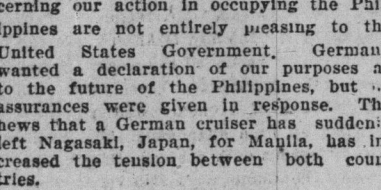
The Kaiser's Government Wants an Answer About the Philippines.

New York, June 10.—(Special to The World, Toronto).—A Washington special to The Journal says: There are strong reasons for saying that our relations with Germany are undergoing a strain. Representations by the German Government concerning our action in occupying the Philippines are not entirely pleasing to the United States Government. Germany wanted a declaration of our purposes as to the future of the Philippines, but assurances were given in response. The news that a German cruiser has suddenly left Nagasaki, Japan, for Manila, has increased the tension between both countries.

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WILL APPROPRIATE SOME DAY.

Mr. Curzon's Strong Hopes for an Anglo-American Treaty.

Sir Julian Pauncefote's Good Work at Washington—Sir Charles Dilke Discredits Salisbury's Policy—England Cannot Mediate in the Present War—House of Commons Proceedings.

London, June 10.—Sir Charles Dilke, advanced Radical member for the Forest of Dean, in the House of Commons, today moved a resolution in the Foreign Office vote, and attacked the Foreign Office's policy of mediation in the present war.

Referring to the United States, he said:

"Our relations with the United States are mainly due to the good influence of Her Majesty's ambassador at Washington (Sir Julian Pauncefote), for the policy of mediation has been rash and feeble. Everyone will welcome an alliance of hearts with America, but no alliance could be a war alliance."

Continuing, Sir Charles said he did not believe in the possibility, mooted by Mr. Joseph Chamberlain, the Secretary of State for the Colonies, of an alliance with Germany.

The Parliamentary Secretary for the Foreign Office, Mr. George N. Curzon, gave credit to the good influence of the British ambassador at Washington.

He said that credit was due not merely to the ambassador or to the exigencies of the moment, but to Lord Salisbury's friendly and dispassionate attitude during the discussion of difficult matters two years ago.

Mr. Curzon added: "An arbitration treaty will be accepted some day."

This statement was greeted with cheering.

Answering a question on the subject, Mr. Curzon said the subjects to be referred to the Arbitration Commission all related to questions between Canada and the United States, but he added some of them are of Imperial interest.

Intervention Not Probable.

Mr. A. B. Raitou, First Lord of the Treasury, replied to a question as to whether, in view of the condition of the population in Cuba, the United States could intervene in the Spanish-American war.

He said: "The United States have no intention of intervening to secure a cessation of hostilities or to negotiate terms of peace."

He said: "Her Majesty's Government will gladly take any favorable opportunity for promoting a cessation of hostilities and for securing peace."
