ANNUAL REPORT.

This is the Nineteenth Report of the Directors of the Halifax Association for Improving the Condition of the Poor. They have the pleasure to acknowledge the receipt of \$1289.75 in donations, particulars of which will be found in the list appended.

LEGACIES.

There has been received from the estate of the late Edward Smith, Esq., the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to be invested, and the interest applied for the objects of the Association. The Bequests which have been received in previous years, and which have been heretofore acknowledged, amount to the further sum of One Thousand Dollars.

Five shares of the Bank of British North America were purchased as an investment, at a cost of \$1334.55.
