RED MENACE TO THE JAPANESE

Bolsheviki Capture Capital of Sakhalin Island

This With Entry Into Northern Korea Indicates Spread of Wave of Invasion of East From the Neighborhood of Vladivostok.

(Associated Press.) Honolulu, Feb. 9—Siberian Bolsheviki have captured Alexandrovisk, capital of the Island of Sakhalin, and fear is felt that the radical forces may enter Japan proper, according to a special cable despatch from the Tokio correspondent of Nippu, Fiji. Honolulu, a Japanese language newspaper.

Reports that the Russian Bolsheviki had made inroads on the Island of Sakhalin reached the United States on Monday, but exact details of their operations were not known. Alexandrovsk is located on the western side of the island and is the eastern terminus of a submarine cable connecting the island with the mainland of Siberia. The island is about 600 miles long and from sixty-five to 105 miles wide. It was under Chinese domination until early in the nineteenth century, when Russia became interested in it. The first permanent Russian settlement was founded in 1857, but the southern part of the island was Japanese until 1875, when it was ceded to Russia. By the treaty of Portsmouth ending the Russo-Japanese war of 1904-1905, the island was divided along the fiftieth degree of

was divided along the fiftieth degree of latitude, territory south of this line being made Japanese.

The capture of Alexandrovsk and the The capture of Alexandrovsk and the incursions of insurgent bands in northern Korea, presumably with the assistance of the Bolsheviki, would seem to indicate a serious menace to Japan from the Reds. Details as to the localities in northern Korea from which Japanese troops are reported to have been forced to retreat are not as yet learned, but it seems probable the Bolsheviki have spread their wave of invasion of the east southward from the neighborhood east southward from the neighborhood of Vladivostok, which is not far from the extreme northern frontiers of Korea.


