DECISION OF THE COURT ON DISPUTED SEATS.

At a Court, held pursuant to the Canon passed at the 17th Session of the said Synod entitled, "A Canon on Disputed Seats in Synod, Present:—S. B. Harman, Registrar of the Diocese, Chairman; the Rev. S. Lett, LL.D.; the Rev. Canon Dixon; C. Magrath, and J. G. Hodgins, LL.D., Esqs., the following cases were considered, and decided as follows:
