The accused, No. B.132698, Pte. Paul Aime Emond, a G.S. soldier of No. 26 Canadian Armoured Corps (Basic) Training Centre, Canadian Army, Orillia, Ontario, is charged with:-

First Charge
Section 15(1)
Army Act.

ABSENTING HIMSELF WITHOUT LEAVE

in that he

at No. 26 Canadian Army (Basic) Training Centre, Canadian Army, Orillia, Ontario, absented himself without leave from No. 26 Canadian Army (Basic) Training Centre, Canadian Army, Orillia Ontario from 0630 hours on the 7th day of December 1942, until apprehended by Service authorities at Montreal, Quebec, at 1545 hours, the 4th day of June 1943, and at the time of his arrest he was dressed in civilian clothes.

The cost of his apprehension and return to his Unit being twenty-one dollars and fifty-seven cents (\$21.57).

ABSENTING HIMSELF WITHOUT LEAVE

in that he

at No. 26 Canadian Army (Basic) Training Centre, Canadian Army, Orillia, Ontario, absented himself without leave from the Guard Room whilst under close arrest at No. 26 Canadian Army (Basic) Training Centre, Canadian Army, Orillia, Ontario, from 2320 hours, the 17th day of June 1943, until he was apprehended at Montreal, Quebec, at 1230 hours, the 18th day of January 1944 by Service authorities, and at the time of his arrest he was dressed in civilian clothes.

The cost of his apprehension and return to his Unit being forty-two dollars and thirteen cents (\$42.13)
