THE EXHIBITION ASSOCIATION. THE PETERS CASE. The only issue of any importance which the opposition candidates in this city and county are raising in this campaign is the dismissal of Mr. R. L. Peters from the position of police magistrate of the city. This was an act which THE GAZETTE considered at the time and which we still condemn, not because we cared anything for Mr. Peters, but because it established what we regarded as a bad precedent. But while condemning this one act of the government in the strongest terms, we do not regard it as an issue of sufficient magnitude to obscure all others. If the restoration of Mr. Peters to the position of magistrate would recompense us for the loss of one million dollars to be expended here for a dry dock and harbor improvements, we might as well be disposed to make his case the leading issue of the campaign; but there is no such prospect. Mr. Peters is at present a civil official in the enjoyment of the handsome salary of \$2000 a year, and the only benefit that would follow his restoration to the magistracy would be the increase of his salary to \$2500. No doubt the addition of an salary would be an advantage to Mr. Peters, but in what way would it recompense the people of St. John for the loss of a dry dock and harbor improvements with all the benefits to the working man which these things will bring? We are not to be misled by these remarks because THE GAZETTE has been censured by

the friends of Mr. Peters for not disregarding all other considerations for his sake. But THE GAZETTE would be false to its record as a paper wholly devoted to the interests of St. John, if it permitted either political or personal considerations to stand in the way of St. John receiving that financial assistance from the province towards the improvement of its harbor which we are justly entitled. We think that the friends of Mr. Peters are making a serious mistake in throwing their name so prominently forward for the purpose of making him appear in the guise of a martyr.
