TORONTO, July 8.—Percy Barrett, the Lambert professional, annexed the open Canadian championship over the Lambert links, leading his nearest competitor, Geo. Cumming of the Toronto Club, by two strokes, 208 to 208. Barrett beat Logey by 8 strokes on every eighteen holes of 72, and the last few were under trying conditions, with a downpour of rain. It was a remarkable feat of steady, clever golf on Barrett's part, and so, too, on Cumming's.
