Commander Robert Peary

It is over twenty years since Commander Peary undertook his first expedition to Greenland and nearly ever since he has been engaged in the exploration of northern Greenland and the regions beyond. In 1900 he reached latitude 83 deg. 30 min. N. on the polar ocean and in 1902 latitude 84 deg. 17 min. N., each time beating the record for the western hemisphere but falling far short of Nansen's and Cagni's records. In 1906 he started from the northern shores of Grant Land just south of the 83 parallel on March 6 with several supporting parties in

front. These were gradually dropped till the only one left was that of his companion in many expeditions, the negro Matthew Hensou delayed by storms and open channels particularly one Big Lead, in front of which he had a camp seven days before a crossing could be effected. Peary pushed on till April 21, reaching on that date latitude 87 deg. 6 min. N. only 174 geological or about 202 statute miles from the pole. His northward progress had been at an average rate of six miles a day Commander Peary reached the Pole on April 6, 1909.
