

ONE ST. JOHN MAN KILLED ANOTHER WOUNDED; SEVERAL N. B. MEN IN CASUALTY LIST

Ottawa, June 7.—York, Kings, Northumberland and Gloucester counties are represented on New Brunswick's roll of honor in today's casualty lists. Hedley C. Hanson, of Burt's Corner, York county, has paid the supreme sacrifice with his life. George McDonald, of Woodstock Road, is wounded; Jerry Langtang, of Loggieville, and M. F. Gregg, of Mountain Vale, Kings county, missing, and Frank Seward, of Caraquet, wounded.

George W. Kane, of Amherst, and several other Nova Scotia men are also in the lists.
