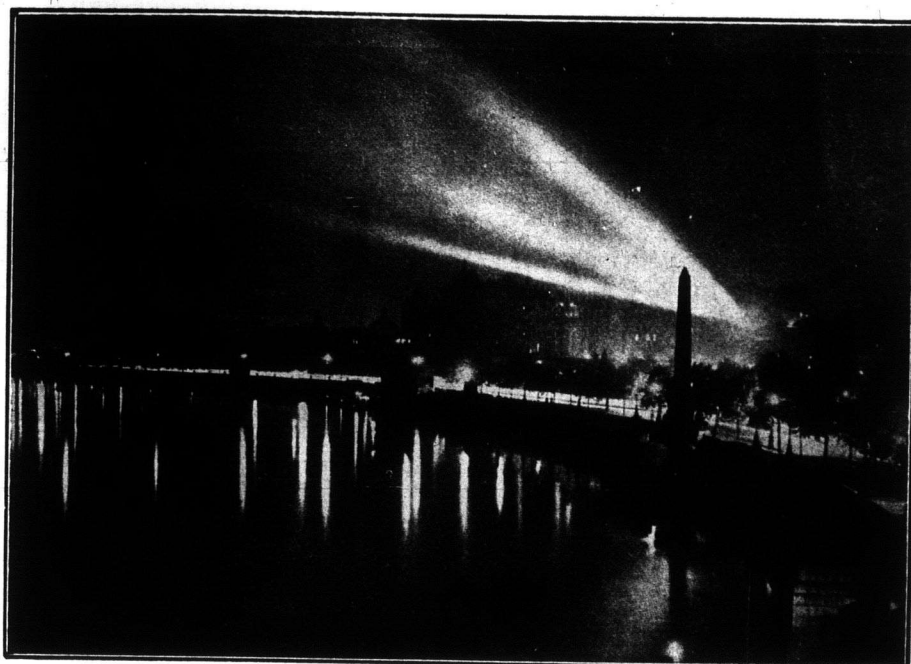
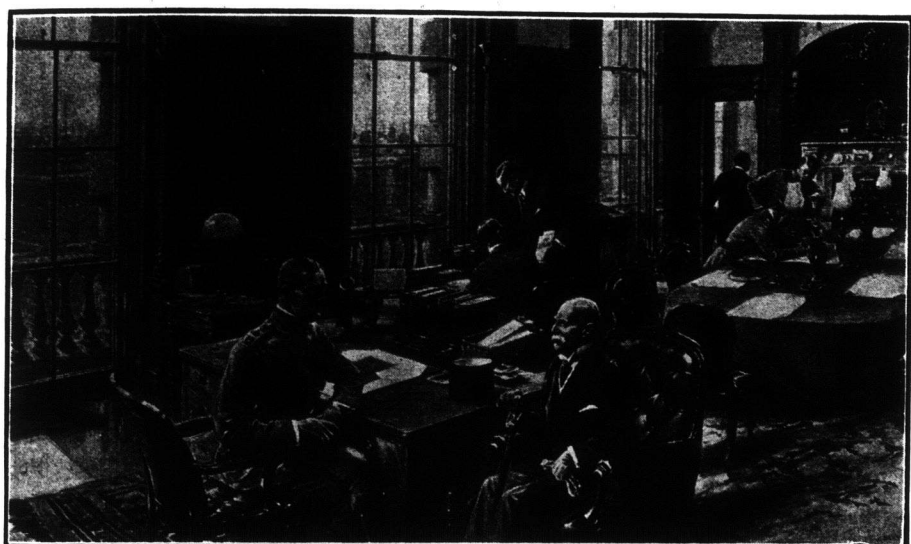


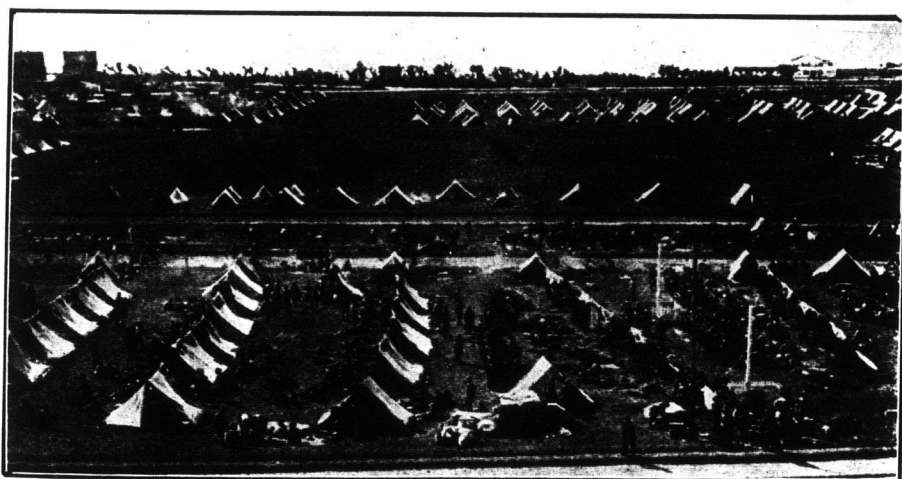
Searchlights on Old Lambeth Bridge, London.

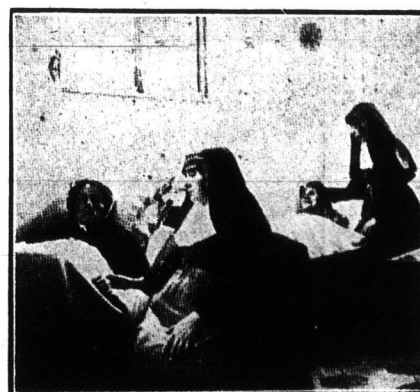
Indian Troops in Camp in France.
