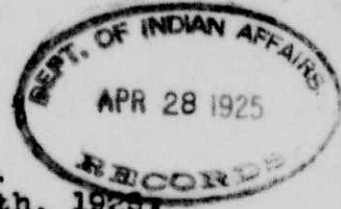

I have a license ^{to cut timber} on some land in the
Whitefish Indian Reserve.

whether we have the right to remove these camps or any
part of them. That is, the lumber with which they are
roofed, or the doors and windows. Or does the Depart-
ment claim any buildings erected on the land while cut-
ting the timber?
