Dear Sir:

I have neglected answering your letter of November 16th owing to absence from the City, and I have now to answer it shortly, rather than to wait to deal with it more extensively.

(1) My opinion of the law, as it stands, appears in the November, 1909, issue of "The Square Deal", at pages 296-7. Other opinions of value are mentioned in the article.

(2) The Trades and Labor Congress of Canada has suggested amendments, a copy of which I enclose herewith.

(3) I do not think the time is ripe for the extension of the Act to all employments.

I should like to say more about the Act, but am pressed for time at the moment and do not wish to delay you.
