OF THE FIRST PART

## AND

HIS MAJESTY THE KING in the right of the PROVINCE OF ALBERTA (hereinafter called the "Province"), represented herein by the Honourable Wallace Warren Cross, Minister of Health,

OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS The Unemployment Relief and Assistance Act, 1936, empowers His Excellency the Governor in Council to enter into agreements with any of the provinces respecting relief measures therein and provides for any payments on account of such relief measures to be made out of moneys appropriated for relief purposes by Parliament for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1937;

AND WHEREAS the Province has made certain proposals to initiate and execute projects for the conservation and development of those of its natural resources hereinafter described as works suitable for the employment of transients and as supplemental to the farm placement project presently in effect;

AND WHEREAS the Province, for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance in the initiation and execution of the aforesaid projects, has requested His Excellency the Governor General in Council to enter into this Agreement and
