Res<sup>d</sup> Sir,

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7<sup>th</sup> inst. suggesting that the school house at Restigouche be used as a hospital for the sick and infirm Indians who you state at present number over twenty; and in reply I beg to inform you that the proposed plan cannot be given effect to. The Department has no funds for the support of a hospital, or for furnishing one; and the school house must not be devoted to such a purpose.
