Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo in further reference to the building of a bridge over the gulch in the pathway to the new school at Koksilah.

In reply I beg to say that the Department is prepared to supply material for constructing this bridge to the extent of \$175.00 and properly certified accounts, in duplicate, for the expenditure incurred should be forwarded to the Department for payment. A competent working foreman should be engaged to look after the work and the rates of wages paid should be reasonable.
