Sir:-

With reference to your communication of the 17th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of the necessary repairs in the way of re-shingling the Mission Church on the Mississauga Reserve being done. A cistern may also be installed. It is observed that it is proposed to have the work done by the day and that the Missionary will supervise the same without charge. The expenditure in the matter should be kept as low as possible. You will be expected to make report to the Department on the work and to have general oversight of the same. The work should be confined to repairs to the roof and the installation of the cistern.
