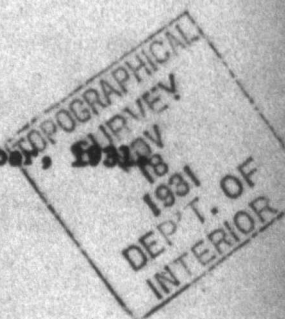

In 1914 patent was received from the Dominion Government covering extra land required at the above Reserve.
