Circular C. No. 93. His Majesty

The King has approved the following arrangements for observance in this country of Armistice Day, November 11th.

No general celebration can take place under the present circumstances. No obstacle will, however, be placed in the way of local observance of the day, if desired, by small communities. Usual Poppy Day collections, under the auspices of the British Legion, will take place on November 11th, and Sunday, November 12th, will be observed as a Day of Dedication.
