Sir,

I have the honor to request to be...
informed whether or not the quantity
of flour and bacon, provided for in the
schedule of this year, will be sufficient
to meet all requirements for your District
until the end of the present fiscal year.
If not you are asked to send in a requis-
ition for the further supply necessary.
Full explanations must accompany the
estimate. You should endeavor to show,
in your statement, the saving you
may be able to make, owing to the crops.

In the past, it has been difficult to
understand the basis on which Agents'
estimates have been made; and, in order
to make them intelligible this year, you
are requested to make out your state-
ment in accordance with the enclosed
form that has been used in the Carlton
Agency, and which meets the require-
ments of this Office.

Kindly send in your requisition as
soon as possible.
