

7. VEHICLE PERMITS - EXHIBITION BARRACKS (CON'T)

3. Appendix to Part I D.O. No. 187 dated 7 Aug. 43 copy attached to these orders is also drawn to the attention of all ranks.
4. Only H.W.E. officer personnel living in barracks will be granted vehicle permits for Stanley Barracks. Applications for Stanley Barracks permits will be approved by the Officer in Charge of Stanley Barracks Area.
5. The Regimental Police will refuse to recognize 1943-44 red stickers after 30 Apr. 44. Private vehicles owned by OR personnel of the Army, will not be admitted in Exhibition Barracks unless a new 1944-45 sticker is conspicuously displayed on the windshield.

8. VEHICLE TRAFFIC - Appendix to Order No. 187, 4/7 AUG. 43.

1. This appendix will cancel appendix to Part I Daily Order No. 259.
2. Personnel will not be permitted to bring motor vehicles within the area of Exhibition Barracks unless in possession of a vehicle permit.
3. Permits will be obtained from Capt. W. W. Poace.
4. Application for permit will be made on the form provided and on evidence of insurance against Fire, Public and Personal Liability, and Operators Licence.
5. Civilian and authorized vehicles will conform to regulations as to speed limits and parking as set forth.
6. Speed Limit - Vehicles will not be driven in a manner that will endanger the lives of pedestrians. The thoroughfares and grounds are primarily used for marching bodies of troops and individuals. Every precaution will be taken to ensure their safety.

Vehicles will NOT be driven at a greater speed than 15 miles per hour at any time.

7. Parking Areas

1. In front of "Q.M." stores, east side of Horticultural Building - Reserved for Army duty cars and official cars.
2. Behind the Hostess Building (Womens Host)
Reserved for visitors to the Hostess Building, Army Personnel
3. Between the International Building and Ontario Building. Reserved for Reception Wing Officers.
4. Behind the Music Building, between Birds Dining Hall and the Fire Hall, the entrances are:-
(a) Opposite the centre of the Grandstand, just east of Bird's Dining Hall, and
(b) Opposite the rear of the Music Building.
5. South of the Horse Palace on the boulevard, by the race track, off the road.
6. East of the Old Midway, off the road.
7. West of the Old Midway, off the road.
8. South of the entrance to the east gate, outside Stanley Barracks.
9. Parking is prohibited in the Exhibition Park, except in the parking areas designated above.
10. Owners and operators of vehicles will strictly observe the regulations laid down by the R.C.N. and R.C.A.F. within these areas.
