The accused, No. M.15943 Tpr. Nixon Ford REID, Canadian Armoured Corps, 11 Canadian Repatriation Depot, C.A.O., is charged with:

FIRST CHARGE
Sec. 40
Army Act

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE CONDUCT TO THE PREJUDICE OF GOOD ORDER AND MILITARY DISCIPLINE.

In that he, about 2300 hours, 2 Oct 45, while standing on a lighted street in full view of the public there present, urinated against the wall of the building at the front of Victoria Station, London.

SECOND CHARGE

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE DISOBEYING IN SUCH MANNER AS TO SHOW WILFUL DEFIANCE OF AUTHORITY, A LAWFUL COMMAND, GIVEN PERSONALLY BY HIS SUPERIOR OFFICER IN THE EXECUTION OF HIS OFFICE.

In that he, on the public street near Victoria Station, London, about 2300 hours, 2 Oct 45, when personally ordered by No. A.57841 Cpl. CLARK, W.M., Canadian Provost Corps No. 6 (Area) Provost Company, then on duty in the vicinity, to then produce his pass and pay book, did not do so but replied to the said Cpl. Clark, "I won't show no fucking Provost my pass".

THIRD CHARGE

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE DISOBEYING A LAWFUL COMMAND GIVEN BY HIS SUPERIOR OFFICER.

In that he, on the public street near Victoria Station, London about 2300 hours, 2 Oct 45, when personally ordered by No. A.57841 Cpl. CLARK, W.M., Canadian Provost Corps No. 6 (Area) Provost Company, then on duty in that vicinity, to then produce his pass and pay book, did not do so but replied to the said Cpl. Clark, "I won't show no fucking Provost my pass".

FOURTH CHARGE
Sec. 10(3)

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE RESISTING AN ESCORT WHOSE DUTY IT WAS TO APPREHEND HIM.

In that he, on the public street near Victoria Station, London, about 2300 hours, 2 Oct 45, resisted by fighting and struggling violently with No. A.57841 Cpl. CLARK, W.M., Canadian Provost Corps, No. 6 (Area) Provost Company, whose duty it then was to apprehend the accused.

FIFTH CHARGE

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE STRIKING HIS SUPERIOR OFFICER BEING IN THE EXECUTION OF HIS OFFICE.

In that he in London, about 2300 hours, 2 Oct 45, while he was being held in arrest in the rear seat of a Canadian Provost (Jeep) vehicle, struck No. A.57841 Cpl. CLARK, W.M., Canadian Provost Corps, No. 6 (Area) Provost Company with his booted foot in the forehead.
