Question by the President.

Have you compared the contents of the above statement with the regimental books? *Answer. Yes. They are certified by the Adjutant.*

Are they true extracts from the regimental books, and is the statement of entries in the conduct sheets a fair and true summary of those entries? *Answer.*

Directions.—If it appear to the satisfaction of the Court that the accused is a respectable character, the Court may, in its discretion, dispense with the evidence of character, and proceed to sentence.
