Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th instant, your File 14/47117, together with enclosure, both dealing with the subject of proposed re-issue of lease to Mr. Charles E. Wilson, covering lands included in Departmental Lease No. 219, cancelled by the Department on January 26th, 1933.

It is not the policy of the Department to re-issue leases to persons who defaulted in payment of rental in connection with previous leasing agreements, and in this case your recommendation is approved, to the effect that Mr. Wilson, the present applicant, should be advised that the Department would not consider the issue of another lease to him unless a very substantial portion of the arrears which were permitted to accumulate under the previous lease were paid in addition to payment of one year's rental, in advance, on a second lease, if and when issued. Your further report in this matter will, no doubt, be received in due course.
