Mission-Study Class Reports

A week-night mission-study class, a Sunday-school class organized for mission study, the study work of boys' and girls' clubs, mission bands and junior societies should all be reported to the pupils of a department or to the main school. This may be done by a résumé of the course or by telling a number of stories illustrating the different topics considered.

Reports of Missionary Service

At least twice a year there should be a public report of the giving and personal missionary service of the school. There should be no boasting and no appearance of display. The motive of service in the face of need should prevail throughout. The character of these reports must be determined locally in view of the kinds and amount of service rendered.
