

of the Society, showing its receipts and disbursements, and summarising the work done during the year, which shall be submitted at the annual general meeting.

9. The Committee may convene a special general meeting of the Society at any time.

#### AUDITORS.

10. Two Auditors shall be elected at the annual general meeting, to examine the current year's accounts and to report thereon at the next annual general meeting.

#### ADMISSION.

11. Applications for membership shall be in writing addressed to the Secretary, signed by the applicant, and shall be accompanied by the recommendation of a member and by the sum of one dollar, being the membership fee for the current year.

12. Members shall be elected by a vote of the Committee.

13. Ladies shall be eligible for membership in the Society.

14. Any lady or gentleman may be admitted as a life member upon payment of ten dollars and shall thereupon be entitled to all the privileges of ordinary members.

#### FEEES.

15. The membership fee shall be one dollar per annum payable in advance.

#### ANNUAL MEETING.

16. The annual meeting of the Society for the election of officers of which due notice shall be given, shall take place during the month of October in each year, unless the Committee shall otherwise order.

#### CONSTITUTION.

17. No alteration or amendment shall be made to this Constitution except by a vote of two thirds of the members present at a general meeting of the Society, notice of which and of the proposed changes in the Constitution shall be given in writing by the Secretary to each member at least one week before the date of such meeting.
