Trading generally continued to broaden during the early part of the week, but latterly the outburst of transactions and the continued upward tendency in Dominion Iron Common overshadowed the rest of the market, and on a business of over 56,000 shares it advanced to 46, reacted to 43½, advanced to 45 again, and closed at 43½ bid, a net gain of 5½ points. The market for Dominion Iron Common was a runaway one, and caution is now necessary. The advances in Detroit United, Montreal Street and Toronto Railway were prominent features, and these stocks all close at substantial gains.
