Many thousands of years ago, this valley was continuous, but suddenly the craters of Red Mountain just above us belched forth with flames and smoke and down its sides flowed stream upon stream of molten rock, sealing up the mountain waters above with a dam built by nature of more solid and lasting construction than any dam built by man's engineering skill. But night is falling, and choosing sandy hollows for beds, we crawl into our sleeping-bags and plan to go to sleep. However, our Professor proceeds to give a lecture on Astronomy and as we look up into the clear sky, he tells us why the Milky Way is milky, why the Pole Star is in the North, and why Saturn has rings, until at last his pupils fall asleep and he alone continues the discourse. 
