the said Charles Baptisse Bouc, Charles Renault, Jean Baptisse Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard, are guilty of the offence in the Indictment aforesaid above specified, in manner and form as by the said Indistruct above against them is alledged: And thereupon the said Jonathan Sewell who for our said Lord the King in this behalf prosecutes, now prayeth that the said Charles Baptiste Bouc, Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard, be committed to the custody of the said Sheriss, and the said Charles Baptiste Bouc, Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard are committed into the custody of the said Sheriss accordingly."

"And afterwards, to wit, on Saturday the ninth day of March, in the thirty ninth year of the reign of our faid Lord the King, before the Justices of our faid Lord the King above named in the faid Court here cometh the faid Jonathan Sewell who profecutes for our faid Lord the King in this behalf, and prayeth the Court here for judgment against the faid Charles Baptiste Bouc, Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard upon the conviction aforesaid: Whereupon it is considered by the Court here that the said Charles Babtiste Bouc be imprisoned in the common gaol of the faid district, during the space of three calendar months, that he do pay a fine of twenty pounds to our faid Lord the King, and that he do find fecurity for his good behaviour for the space of three years next after his discharge, he the said Charles Baptifle Boue in the fum of five hundred pounds, and two fureties in the fum of two hundred pounds each, and that the said Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard be severally imprisoned in the said gaol for the space of three weeks, and that they the said Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Goll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard do severally pay a fine of fix shillings and eight pence to our faid Lord the King, which faid Charles Baptiste Boue being prefent here under the custody of the said Sherist, is fined for the said offence twenty pounds, to the use of our said Lord the King, and the said Charles Baptifle Bone is committed to the common gaol of the faid district, there to remain for the space of three calendar months; and the said Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard, being also present here, under the custody of the said Sheriff, are severally fined for the offence aforesaid, six shillings and eight pence to the use of
