An engroffed Bill to regulate the payment of Monies due to the Province, for Provifions fupplied to the Inhabitants, was read a third time.

Resolved, That the Bill do pais, and that the title be, An Act to regulate the payment of Monies due to the Province, for Provisions supplied to the Inhabitants, and to apply the fame to the fervice of Roads and Bridges.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the foregoing Bills, and also the Bill to continue in force the feveral Acts therein mentioned, to the Council, and defire their concurrence.

A Meffage from the Council, by Mr. Cogfwell,

Mr. Speaker,

The Council have agreed to a Bill, entitled, An Act for the encouragement of the Cod and Scale Fisheries of the Province, without any amendment.

And then the Meffenger withdrew.

The House proceeded to the confideration of the amendments made by the Council, to the Bill in, addition to the Act for the repairing, keeping in repair, cleaning and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, and the same were read throughout a first and second time, and thereupon,

Resolved, That a conference be desired with the Council, on the subject matter of the faid amendments, and that the Clerk do request the same.

The Clerk reported that the Council had agreed to the conference, as defired by the Houfe.

Ordered, That Mr. Pryor, Mr. Archibald and Mr. Haliburton, do manage the faid conference.

And they went to the conference.

And being returned,

Mr. Pryor reported that the Managers had been at the conference; and flated the fubfiance of the conference to the House.

A Meffage from the Council, by Mr. Cogswell,

Mr. Speaker,

The Council have agreed to a Bill, entitled, An Act to regulate the payment of Monies due to the Province, for Provisions supplied to the Inhabitants, and to apply the fame to the fervice of Roads and Bridges; also,

A Bill, entitled, An Act to empower the Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, to appoint Commissioners to islue Treasury Notes; and allo,

A Bill, entitled, An Act to continue in force the feveral Acts therein mentioned, feverally without any amendment.

And then the Meffenger withdrew.

The Clerk, purfuant to order, prefented to the Houfe an engrofied Bill, for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies, granted in this Seffion of the General Affembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province, and the faid Bill was read, and thereupon,

Resolved, That the Bill do país, and that the title be, An Act for applying certain Monies therein mentioned, for the fervice of the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen, and for appropriating such part of the Supplies granted in this Seffion of the General Assembly, as are not already appropriated by the Lawsor Acts of the Province.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Council, and defire their concurrence.
