or Juiters, shall be made Returnable at least Seven Days, after their Dates Reportively.

And be it further enacted, That the Form of the Writts to be iffied by the Julices of the Peace, for the Recovery of small Debt. Thall be by Summons only in the following Form.

TN his Majesty's Name you are hereby Commanded to Summon A. B. of if he may be found in your Precinct, to be and appear before His Majestr's Justice of the Peace for Said County, at the Dwelling House of on Day being the of the Clock in the Day of Noon, then and there to answer to C. D. of. a Plea of to the Damage of the said C. D. as says the Sum of which will then and there make appear, and do you make due Return of this Summons, with your doings shereon to before said Day Witness Hand and Seal this in the Year of His Majesty's Reign, Day of Annoque Domini 17

A Copy of which shall be left with the Desendant at his last place of abode at least Seven Days before the Trial.

And be it enasted, That all Writs of Execution issued by the said Justices shall run against the Goods and Chattles of the Defendant, and for want thereof to take the Body of the said Defendant.

And be it enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in Force for the space of Two Years from the Publication thereof, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General-Assembly.
