BELL MEMORIAL

which his father, the late Professor A. Melville Bell, presented to King George on the occasion of his last visit to the city, some ten years ago.

Senator Robertson, the newly appointed labor representative to the Dominion cabinet, on his first day in office represented the Borden union minority at the unveiling, expressing deep appreciation of the honor thus conferred upon him. He recalled the fact that the telephone was first conceived by Dr. Bell in the month of August of the year 1876, and that he held forth hope that Canada might produce many more sons of such calibre as Alexander Graham Bell.

How W. D. McPherson representing the provincial government at the event, considered it particularly auspicious and worthy of note that the memorial was unveiled in the lifetime and in the very presence of the man whom it honored, declaring the occasion one of unalloyed happiness that Professor Bell was able to attend in full health and strength, and in the midst of his family and personal declaration that the world's greatest invention, the telephone, was not easily to be set aside.

At the Bell Homestead this afternoon, the following address was read by E. L. Gould, chairman of the Parks Board, to the Governor General who dedicated the home:
To His Excellency the Duke of Devonshire, K. G., Governor-General of Canada.

As Chairman of the Board of Park Commissioners of the City of Brantford, it is with much pleasure and pride, upon behalf of my fellow Commissioners and myself, that I am called upon to accept of your hands the Deed of the Bell Homestead, the Homestead which many years ago was occupied by Professor Melville Bell and his distinguished son, Dr. Alexander Graham Bell, and where the invention of the telephone was consummated.
