ABY-LAW Fixing the rate of interest payable on un rates and taxes on land or improvement special or otherwise, or upon real prop

WHEREAS under and by virtue of sections of the "Municipal Act, 1892," as amen by section 17 of the "Municipal Act Amment Act, 1896," it is provided that rates and taxes on land or real improveme special or otherwise, or on real prope which are unpaid on the 31st day of Decemin each year, shall bear interest therefuntil paid in full at the rate of not exceed six (6) per cent, per annum;

And whereas it is necessary and expedien fix the rate of interest which shall be pays as aforesald;

Be it therefore enacted by the Mun'c Council of the District Municipality of Deas follows:
