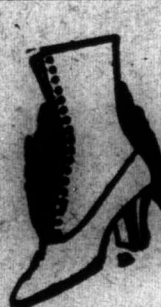

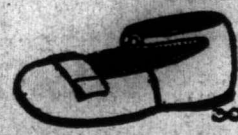

The dog show always attracts a large number of interested admirers, and as in the past, this promises to be an exhibit well worth visiting.

THIRTY NEW ELEVATORS To be Built in Saskatchewan of Which Six Are Already Completed

Of the thirty new elevators to be built this season by the Saskatchewan Co-operative Elevator Co. at various points throughout the province six have already been completed and six additional elevators are in course of construction, the company having been enabled to make an earlier start with this work than in any previous year. Commencing operations in the season of 1910-11 with forty-seven elevators, the company has now two hundred and thirty elevators in service, and the total number will thus be increased to 260 when the present season's programme of construction has been completed.

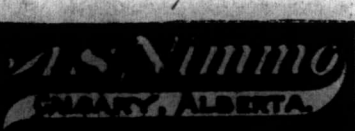

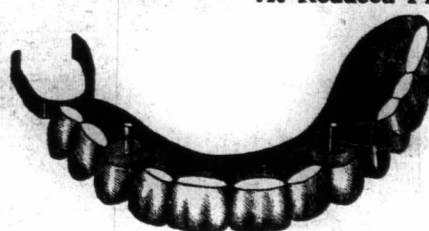
