WHAT IS GOING ON OF INTEREST TO CANUCKS.

The crops in the North-west look well. Flour has dropped 20c a barrel in Winnipeg. Bishop Usher, of the Reformed Episcopal Church, Montreal, has resigned. Ontario excursionists to the number of 60 arrived in Winnipeg Friday.

Hon. John Hamilton, Justice of the Supreme Court, British Columbia, is dead. Gen. Sir Fred Middleton will inspect the military camp at Niagara on the 18th inst. John Rolston, a leading merchant of Montreal, Ont., is dead, leaving a wife and one child.

The funeral of Mr. F. Broughton at Eastwood Thursday was largely attended by railway men and others. Dr. J. A. Temple, Toronto, was elected president of the Ontario Medical Association for the ensuing year.

It is rumored that the Dominion Government will make a grant in aid of the Johnston sufferers. A legacy of \$2,000, left by Mr. John Clark of Montreal, to "Honorable Clarke, Ottawa, Ont.," is awaiting an executor.

The condition of Morrison, the Megantic outlaw, is causing his friends alarm. He is suffering greatly from his wounds. A young lad at Kingston swallowed a dose of Paris green to terminate his earthly career.

A Chinaman in bond, and travelling in a freight car, arrived at Ottawa from Vancouver the other day. A man named Edward Hornbostle was killed by a railway train at Guelph Thursday last.

The Executive Committee are arranging for an extensive celebration of Dominion Day in Toronto. Mrs. J. McCallum was re-elected President of the Canada Congregational Women's Missionary Society yesterday.

Carleton Place council offers a reward of \$50 for the arrest of a dog poisoner who has been operating in that place. Miss McLennan, who recently cut her throat at Montreal, was driven to the desperate aid by neuralgia pains.

The Brampton jail has not a prisoner within its walls. It is seven or eight years since the jail was in the same fix. The next meeting of the Supreme Court of the Independent Order of Foresters will be held at Brockville in August.

It is expected that ex-President Cleveland and a party of friends will spend some time fishing on the St. Lawrence this season. J. B. Rouillard, proprietor of a Social newspaper, has taken an action for \$500 damages against L'Etendard for alleged libel.

Henry Sandham, the well-known Montreal painter has been accorded sittings for a portrait by Sir John Macdonald. It is reported that Atkinson has offered to compromise with the relatives of Scott, the victim of the Mono fray, by the payment of \$1000.

The old fanning mill factory in the north-west part of the town of Simcoe was destroyed by fire and the residence of Mr. J. Carson, near by, was considerably damaged. Mr. Pridham, of Australia, is at present in Montreal, investigating the possibilities of the Canadian Pacific railway route in connection with a mail service between Australia and Canada.

Rev. T. C. Vance, of London, Eng., has arrived in Montreal with 100 immigrants, the first of 600 who are being sent out by the English Self Help Emigration Society. Application has been made to the Customs Department for leave to bring into Canada, free of duty, mining machinery for boring for oil and natural gas.

White Caps have made their appearance in Amherstburg, Ont., and Wednesday night unmercifully whipped Alex. Pinesaw for being a habitual drunkard and refusing to support his family. It is stated that Mr. J. C. Patterson, M. P. for North Essex, will seek the representation of South Essex at the next Dominion general election.

Messrs. Hiram Walker & Sons, of Windsor, on Thursday shipped a consignment of liquor to Honolulu and one to Yokohama, Japan. Hon. William Macdougall is of the opinion that under the authority of the Supreme Court Act the Government can bring the constitutionality of the Quebec Jesuit Act before the Supreme Court.

Mr. Van Horne, says that while immigration to the North-West from Europe is at least one hundred per cent greater than it has ever been before. At the convocation of Toronto University the honorary degree of L.L.D. was formally bestowed on Sir John Macdonald, Chancellor for Royal, Mr. Oliver Mowat, Mr. W. B. Meredith, D. W. P. Atkins, Rev. The loveliest colors and shadings are seen in the gauzes, nets, bolting cloths, tulle, and lace that cover the dressiest parasols this season. Pretty little parasolets are mounted on pointed sticks, by which they can be carried into sunshades in a carriage drive or on the street.

Striped flannel is the material most used for tennis costumes. A wool and silk stripe is also popular for the tennis skirt, with a blouse made of washing silk. A knitted blouse waist, which may be worn with any skirt, has recently been manufactured by an enterprising firm, and it is likely to be popular for cool summer days.

The dark blue, brown, or black fancy straw hat in Watteau shape, with a low crown, deep brim in front and narrow in the back, is the most fashionable for girls of 12 and 14.

The lace flounce is now put on the inside of the dressy parasol, extending from the supports of the ribs to the edge of the frame or canopy, where it forms a full, deep volants or ruffle. The Torsador waistcoat, made wholly of embroidery, to wear under Empire or Directory jackets of velvet, go well with stylish indoor afternoon and at-home-in-the-evening toilets.

The parasol of chaille, veiling, satteen and China silk to match the material or the gown is a feature on parasol counters, or rather on the counters where those dress gowns are shown. Smoke-gray tulle, garnished with silver tinsel and silver thistles, makes a lovely ball gown for a pretty girl, but she must have a good complexion and high color to become her gown. The Watteau fluff, with wide brim projecting over the forehead and short in the back, low in the crown and trimmed with field-flowers in front, is the out-of-door, on-the-awn, and piazza hat of the Oranges.

The richest gowns for afternoon reception wear are trained and are made with polonaises, also trained, opening in front over rich petticoats of brocade, or over embroidered and lace-trimmed silk skirts. Tennis dresses are not always made with simple blouse waists. They were some in route for Moose Jaw, N. W. T. They were proceeding leisurely, having been on the road for three weeks.

New Pastry Bread is Made. In the preparation of the Jewish Passover bread the kneading is done in the ordinary way. Pure gunpowder water is the only component added. The time for the dough to be baked is reduced to the minimum. It is taken into flat cakes and then run between rollers into very thin sheets. Over these a workman rolls a prolonged steel to perforate the dough, so that air holes may be seen in the baked cakes. A steel hoop puts the dough into round, flat sheets, which are then ready for the oven. The baker stands with a saddle astride to a very long handle. With the aid of a boy he thrusts the cakes into the brick apartment, and in half a minute pulls them out ready for use. A matzoh cake is round, about four feet in diameter, somewhat browned and having slight air hole projections of its surface. They have a rather pious taste, unlike that of crackers, and make a good substitute for bread. In some places there is a demand throughout the entire year for the unleavened cakes for dyspeptic. About eight cakes weigh a pound, which in large quantities sell at eight cents. The cakes are very brittle, and their pieces are ground up into fine meal. This is the substitute for wheat flour in the household during the Passover.—Baltimore Sun.
