### HIGH SCHOOL ENTRANCE

List of Successful Pupils at Aylmer and Vienna.

The course prescribed by the education department for the high school entrance examinations is now divided into two parts.

Part 1 includes literature, art, history, nature study, physiology and hygiene.

On these subjects there is no examination held by the high school board of examiners, but before pupils may be admitted as candidates at the examination on the subjects of Part 1, a teacher is required to furnish the inspector a certificate stating that his pupils have satisfactorily covered the course prescribed in the subjects of Part 1.

The literature embraces the careful reading of the pupils during the year of four books in English literature chosen by the teacher from a list selected by the inspector.

The subjects of Part 1, are:—reading, writing, spelling, arithmetic, grammar, composition and geography. These are the subjects of the high school entrance examination. To pass candidates are required to obtain 40 per cent. on each subject and 60 per cent. on the total.
