# STANDARDIZE LAWS

Sir James Aikens, Manitoba, Claims Legislation Arises Out of Following Precedent.

Canadian Press Despatch. Montreal, Aug. 30 .- An appeal for a greater degree of standardization in provincial legislation was made here today by Sir James Aikens, lieutenant-governor of Manitoba, addressing as president, the conference of commissioners on uniform laws. Sir James said the purposes of the commissioners were "to secure uni-formity in the lex scripta of provincial enactments governing the same activity or thing, in commercial and kindred subjects," and "to obviate conflicting decisions of courts in different provinces upon the same ques-tion arising out of identical or similar facts, and under statutes sub-stantially alike in principle or varying only in phrases expressing those

Conflict of decisions resulted mainly, he said, from a "slavish following of precedent."

"Too often," declared Sir James, "Judge-made law arises out of that unreasonable following of precedent upon precedent, and so eventually i digs the grave of statutory or remeenactment or amendment and buries it. Judges are fallible, some more so than others, and the decision of the weakest of them, while it stands, is cited and followed as precedent, and divergence thus grows."

## **GOVERNMENT OFFERS IMMIGRANTS POSITIONS**

Manitoba Agrees To Find Employment For Harvesters From Britain.

Canadian Press Despatch. Winnipeg, Aug. 30.—The dissatis-faction which has existed among 200 narvester immigrants in this city is believed to have been ameliorated by the offer of the Saskatchewan gov ernment to take all the men and place them in harvesting jobs at \$4 a day, according to Capt. Alex. Crossman of Glasgow, "vicechairman." resigned his position after describing as "shirkers" those who do not want to work for what has been offered them. "We were offered construction work today until we could get jobs at \$4, or until we could earn enough to pay our passage back," he said. "It's doing nobody any good our sitting around the immigration hall and eating what the citizens of Canada provide for us. I don't want charity. I want work."

### LAUNCH MOST POWERFUL BATTLESHIP IN U. S. NAVY
