Montreal Stock Market.

LOW PRICED STOCKS ACTIVE - RE-NEWED ACTIVITY AND HIGHER PRICES IN OTHER STOCKS - WAR CRITICAL BUT NOT SITUATION ALARMING.

Montreal, Nov. 7.

Today there still exists a considerable movement in lower priced stocks which were in evidence yesterday, and besides this, which was yesterday's feature the higher priced securities have again begun working. Duluth may have got a start in the market through the almost total absence of stock selling over par, but it continues holding the market at yesterday's prices by its own merit.
